### About us

The main goal of Aids Hilfe Wien is to prevent new infections and to support people living with HIV/AIDS. In order to do so, Aids Hilfe Wien provides anonymous and free of charge HIV antibody testing and professional counselling and information in all languages. In our house, there is also a daycare center for people living with HIV/AIDS where we offer meals at low cost and varied activities. Moreover, we conduct numerous prevention and education programs.

### Testing service

We provide individual counselling and anonymous HIV-testing as well as screening for syphilis and hepatitis B and C.

Unfortunately, we cannot provide all tests free of charge. Below you can find information on the costs. Please keep in mind that the period of time after the exposure to a possible risk situation varies for the referred test to be accurate:

- The laboratory HIV antibody test is free of charge and gives an accurate result after 6 weeks
- The HIV rapid test costs € 26,- and gives an accurate result after 12 weeks
- The HIV PCR costs € 69,- and gives an accurate result after 2 weeks
- The hepatitis B and C test costs € 23,-
- The hepatitis C test costs € 14,-
- The syphilis tests costs € 6,-

Testing times at Aids Hilfe Wien are:

- Monday and Wednesday from 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.
- Thursday from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.
- Friday from 2:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

You will receive a personal pre- and post-test counselling, where you have the possibility to talk about all your questions and needs.
